ADMISSION NOTICE FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 – 2021

- 1. The "Common Entrance Test (CET) for admission in all Pre-Sea maritime Courses is mandatory as per DGS Training Circular No 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020.
- 2. Accordingly Indian Maritime University (IMU) will conduct Common Entrance Test (CET) on all India basis for Admission in Directorate General of Shipping (DGS) approved Maritime Training Institutes. Hence candidates seeking admission to MTIs (affiliated to any University) to Pre-Sea courses are required to qualify in CET.
- 3. All India online Common Entrance Test (CET) will be conducted on 30/08/2020. Last date for online Application and Registration for CET is 03/08/2020. Link for registration is operational in the official website www.imu.edu.in
 - Application Fee for Registration Rs. 1000/- (General / OBC) & Rs. 700/- (SC/ST)
- 4. The Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission in B. Sc (Nautical Science) as per **DGS Training** Circular 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020.

Minimum eligibility criteria for admission in pre-sea maritime courses:

General information:

- a) Candidates must be medically fit including eye sight and hearing as prescribed in the Merchant Shipping (Medical Examination) Rules, 2000, as amended.
- b) Part Time or Distance Learning or Correspondence Course or any combination of these will not be considered.
- c) The minimum and maximum ale limits mentioned in DGS Training Circular 12 of 2020 shall be considered as on the date of commencement of the pre-sea maritime course.
- d) The maximum age limit mentioned below shall be applicable for General Category candidates.
- e) The maximum age limit for candidates belonging to "Scheduled Caste" (SC) / "scheduled Tribe" (ST) Category shall be relaxed by 5 years.
- f) The maximum age limit for candidates belonging to Non-creamy layer of "other Backward Classes' (OBC) Category shall be relaxed by 3 years.
- g) The maximum age limit for women candidates of each Category shall be relaxed by additional 2 years
