Reporting: You are required to report at HIMSAR campus Haldia at 1000 Hrs on 9th AUGUST 2017. Haldia is located in S. E. Railway and well connected from Howrah as well as Khargpur. There is direct local train at various times from Howrah as well as Panskura. It is also accessible by road from Howrah/Macheda via NH- 41. Parents/relatives are permitted to accompany the candidates to HIMSAR for Admission. Parents / Relatives are requested to leave the Premises of HIMSAR after Admission process is over. There is no residential accommodation for visitors. Last train for Howrah from Haldia is at 1700 hrs from Haldia station. Other modes of transport are available upto 1900 Hrs.

2. Fees - A demand draft of any Nationalised Bank in favour of HIMSAR payable at Haldia for Rs 1,00,000/- (One lac) is to be deposited at the time of joining e.g. 09/08/2017. Other charges are to be paid at actual as per Break- up of Fees to be obtained from Admission cell.

3. Documents to be submitted at the time of Joining (original along with six sets of Xerox):

- (i) Joining instruction is to be downloaded and to be brought along with while joining.
- (ii) Proof of date of birth in original. For this purpose DOB mentioned in 10th pass certificate and mark sheet is only acceptable.
- (iii) 12th class Pass Certificate and mark sheet in original issued by Registrar/Secretary of the university/board of the examining Body with Mathematics , Physics, Chemistry and English as Separate subjects.
- (iv) Migration Certificate from Registrar/ Secretary of University/ Board.
- (v) 8 Passport size photographs (front view both ears visible) in white shirt with blue back ground.
- (vi) Bio- data of the candidate (to be duly filled in the enclosed proforma Annexure -1)
- (vii) Indemnity Bond (to be duly filled in the enclosed Proforma Annexure -II)
- (viii) Declaration by the parents to be duly signed as per enclosed proforma (Annexure -III)
- ix) Declaration by Candidate for Board validation duly signed as per enclosed proforma– (Annexure -IV)
- (x) Anti Ragging Affidavits to be duly signed and notarized in the enclosed proformas (Annexure- V&VI)
- (xi) If applicable SC/ST certificate in original issued by the competent authority.
- (xii) If applicable OBC (Non creamy layer) certificate in original issued by competent authority.

4. Admission is provisional subject to:

- (i) All documents are authentic and are in order.
- (ii) Passing the Medical examination conducted by DGS approved Medical Practitioner under MS Notice No. 1 of 2015 and complying with all applicable guidelines. The medical examination if required can be arranged by HIMSAR. The fees for the medical examination has to be borne by the candidate and to be paid by the candidate directly to the concerned Doctor/ Lab.
- (iii) Confirmation of eligibility/registration /enrolment for admission at first year B.sc (Nautical science) degree course issued by the MAKAUT, WB.

Any suppression of the Truth, misrepresentation of facts for false information in any of the essential requirements will result in cancellation of admission and forfeiture of fees and render the candidate liable to Prosecution.

5. Discipline:

Cadets are exposed to a balanced programme of both general and professional education necessary for their eventual success as Navigating officer in the Merchant Navy. Improper conduct reflecting undesirable Character, use of alcohol, drugs tobacco (in any form) or visit to places of ill repute ragging etc are Punishable by immediate dismissal. Parents are requested to Co- operate and assist the authorities in maintaining a high standard of discipline in the institution.

We have zero tolerance to any incident of ragging and the society is having in place necessary orders to have ragging free campus.

6. Medical Facility

Cadets get First Aid Medical facilities from First Aid centre of ICARE. Cadets can also avail the outdoor and indoor facilities of the hospital of the society by paying nominal fees. There is also government Sub divisional Hospital in Haldia. Ambulance is available at all time in the Campus.

7. Passport

Attested copies of Passport is very essential for issuance of CDC (document issued to seafarer by Govt of India). All those candidates who are not having Passport, they must apply for the Passport.

8. General points to be noted for compliance:

- (i) Gold ornaments and other valuables are not allowed.
- (ii) Electrical apparatus / heater / Hot plate / Induction plates.
- (iii) Cadets are not allowed to keep Motor Vehicles /bicycles.
- (iv) Cadets are advised not to keep more than Rs 1000 in cash.
- (v) Instead Cadets can open their account in Syndicate Bank located in the Complex.
- (vi) Uniforms to be worn at all times during training
- (vii) Mobiles are not allowed during class hours. It is strictly prohibited and if caught will be confiscated. Smart phones are prohibited only. Mobile for voice communication is allowed.
- (viii) Smoking and Drinking is strictly prohibited in the campus and outside campus.
- (ix) All rules and regulation of the institute should be strictly followed which are issued from time to time by the head of the institute.
